## Sabbath, New Moon, & Feast Days

A Biblical "day" begins and ends at sunset, rather than at midnight. In Genesis 1:5 [KJV], the story of creation, it says, "And the evening and the morning were the first day." From this, we conclude that a day begins with evening, that is, sunset. Sabbath, New Moon, & Feast Days Begin the evening before the date specified and end at nightfall of the date specified, that is, at the time when it becomes dark outside, about an hour after sunset. Leviticus 23:32b [KJV] "...from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath."

# **Levitical Feast Days**

### Feast Days begin the evening *before* the date specified. Leviticus 23:32b [KJV] "...from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath."

The 1<sup>st</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> days of Pesach are Sabbath Days Lev. 23:5-8 [кjv]

5 In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is the LORD's passover.

- 6 And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.
- 7 In the first day ye shall have an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein.
- 8 But ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD seven days: in the seventh day is an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein.
